Tracheostomy Notes

Elective tracheostomy done LRA by ENT Duty team on 1st July

- 1. Patient laid Supine.
- Patient positioned. Parts cleaned & draped
- Incision marked.
- 2% Lignocaine Adr. infiltrated along marked incision.
- Incision given 2cm above sternal notch to thyroid notch.
- Soft tissue dissected and retracted.
- Strap muscle retracted.
- Trachea confirmed.
- Pretracheal fascia incised and incision given in trachea. Stoma widened.
- Stay Sutured ~~to~~ given in trachea.
- 3.5mmuffed T-tube inserted and Cuffed inflated. Stay Sutured placed.
- ~~At~~ Air Entry present. All Air Entry confirmed by Pediatric team.
- T-tube Secured.
- Hemo stable & achieved.
- Dressing done.

Adv

- Don't change T-tube ~~at~~ for 1st 72 hrs.
- Daily Dressing.
- Non traumatic Suction.
- Deflate cuff ~~at~~ for 5min every 2 hrs.
- Get check x-ray chest.
